NCRA has built the Giant Metrewave Radio Telescope (GMRT) at Khodad near Narayangaon, Taluka-Junnar, District-Pune operates both GMRT and Ooty Radio Telescope (ORT), Udhagamandalam.

3. Bidders are advised to carefully read the "Guidelines to Bidders on CPPP's e-Procurement Module" provided at the end of this tender document before submitting their bids.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS and SCOPE OF WORK

NCRA Pune provides medical facilities including the supply of medicines to its employees (serving & retirees) and their dependent family through its medical scheme, namely NCRA Contributory Medical Scheme (NMS), under which a number of hospitals and laboratories are empanelled. NCRA also operates a clinic in its Pune campus from 1000 hrs to 1700 hrs from Monday to Saturday (except closed holidays).

- a) Based on historical records, the annual turnover from the dispensing of medicines through the medical shop has been approximately ₹250 lakh to ₹300 lakh. Please note that the turnover figures are indicative only and do not constitute any guarantee.
- b) We invite Expressions of Interest (EOI) from well-established and licensed medicine suppliers/ pharmacy/medical shop operators, preferably located in Pune and in proximity to NCRA-TIFR, for the dispensing of medicines to beneficiaries of the NCRA Medical Scheme (NMS).
- c) The selected agency shall be required to dispense medicines between 10:00 hrs and 14:00 hrs on all working days from Monday to Saturday (excluding closed holidays), at discounted rates.
- d) The EOI is being invited through the Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) from eligible and licensed medicine dealers located in Pune. Selection will be based on the highest percentage discount offered on the Maximum Retail Price (MRP) of medicines and related pharmaceutical items, subject to compliance with the terms and conditions of the EOI.
- e) The successful party will be decided among the parties who accept the Terms and Conditions as mentioned in the successive paragraphs and who offer the maximum discount on the retail price of the Medicine and other medical-related items. If finalised, the successful party will have to enter into an agreement/contract with NCRA. This agreement will be for a total period of one year at a time.
- f) The Chemist/ Medical Store/ Medicine dealer or his representative shall always be contactable/ approachable over phone and otherwise on all days. The vendor should have an official email ID and official contact number
- g) Interested suppliers shall quote a uniform percentage discount on the MRP applicable to all categories of medicines and medical supplies. The selected supplier shall be responsible for payment of all applicable taxes, duties, levies, and other statutory charges as per prevailing laws. The supplier shall also bear all expenses related to packaging, handling, transportation, delivery, and any other incidental costs associated with supplying medicines and medical items to locations specified by NCRA-TIFR.
- h) NCRA-TIFR shall make payment based on the printed MRP of the supplied items, less the discount offered and accepted under the contract. The quoted discount percentage shall remain firm and valid throughout the entire contract period.
- i) The selection of the Medicine Supplier will be based primarily on the maximum percentage discount offered on the MRP of medicines and related medical supplies, subject to fulfilment of all eligibility criteria and terms and conditions specified in the EOI document.
- j) The Centre Director, NCRA-TIFR, Pune reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications/offers, either wholly or partially, without assigning any reason whatsoever. The decision of NCRA-TIFR in this regard shall be final and binding.
- k) Only those Medicine Suppliers who satisfy the prescribed eligibility criteria and agree to comply with all terms and conditions contained in the EOI document shall be eligible to participate in the process.

1. Eligibility Criteria

- **1.1** The Medicine Supplier should be a Proprietary Firm / Partnership Firm / LLP / Private Limited Company / Limited Company etc. registered with the appropriate authority.
- **1.2** A valid PAN and GST Registration certificate should be available with the Medicine Supplier.
- **1.3** The Medicine Supplier must hold valid licenses as on the date of bid issued by the Drug Control Authority of the State under the provisions of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940. They must hold all other licenses, clearances and permissions as may be necessary to carry out the trade of dealing with / sealing of medicines. The Medicine Supplier should possess a valid license during the contract period.
- **1.4** The Chemist/Medical Store/Medicine dealer stores should be in existence continuously for at least the last 03 years.
- **1.5** The Medicine Supplier must not have been convicted by the State Drugs Authorities and no case should be pending under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act and Rules.
- **1.6** The average annual financial turnover of the Medicine Supplier during the last three years ending on 31.03.2025 should be at Rs. 10 Lacs (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only) as per the audited balance sheet and profit & loss account of the relevant period, duly authenticated by a Chartered Accountant/ Cost Accountant. The net worth of the bidder firm should not be negative as on 31.03.2025.
- **1.7** The Medicine Supplier should not have been indicated for any criminal, fraudulent or corruption activity / blacklisted/debarred by any Central/State Govt./Semi Govt./ PSU/ Autonomous body.
- **1.8** The shop/establishment of a Medicine Supplier should be situated in Pune, preferably in proximity to NCRA-TIFR, Pune.
- **1.9** The Medicine Supplier have a functional computerized billing system capable of generating itemised bills (Medicine Name, Batch No, Expiry, MRP, Discount and Net Amount).
- **1.10** Bid must be valid for a minimum period of 60 days from the due date for submission of the bid.

2. Delivery of Medicines & Logistics

- **2.1 Collection:** An authorised representative must collect prescriptions from the Medical Officer (MO) at NCRA four times daily (**10:30 am, 11:30 am, 12:30 pm, 1:30 pm**) from Monday to Saturday except closed holidays. "Failure to collect prescriptions for two consecutive slots without prior intimation shall be treated as a service lapse."
- **2.2 Timelines:** Medicines must be delivered within **01 hour** of collection at the NCRA clinic. "In case of 'Life-Saving' or 'Urgent' remarks by the Medical Officer (MO), the pharmacy must deliver the medicine within **30 minutes**, regardless of the routine collection schedule."
- **2.3 Home Delivery:** If a prescribed medicine cannot be supplied within the 60-minute window for whatsoever reason, it must be delivered to the beneficiary's residence by the following day at **no extra cost**.
- **2.4 Substitution:** Strictly prohibited. In exceptional cases, substitution requires prior written approval from the MO, NCRA.
- **2.5 Direct Sales:** Non-prescribed medicines requested by beneficiaries must be billed and collected separately from the individual; NCRA bears no responsibility for these payments.
- **2.6 Stocking:** The pharmacy shall maintain adequate stock of commonly prescribed medicines to ensure a 0% stock-out rate.

3. Billing & Payment System

- **3.1 Submission:** Computerised bills must be submitted with original prescriptions and beneficiary acknowledgements.

- **3.2 Cycle:** OPD bill statements must be submitted to the Administrative Officer, NCRA on the **10th, 20th, and 30th** of every month.
- **3.3 Payment:** Payments will generally be released via NEFT/Cheque within 30 days of correct document submission.
- **3.4 Transparency:** The agreed discount must be explicitly indicated on every bill.
- **3.5 Price Protection:** "In the event of a reduction in MRP by the Government/NPPA, the benefit must be passed on to NCRA immediately."
- **3.6** "Bills with manual corrections, overwriting, or fluid erasures will be summarily rejected. All discounts must be calculated on the **current MRP** at the time of sale."

4. Quality, Ethics & Storage

- **4.1 Standards:** Medicines must strictly conform to the brand/quality specified. **No generic medicines are allowed** unless specifically endorsed by the MO.
- **4.2 Counterfeit Policy:** Supply of spurious or expired medicines will result in **immediate termination** and reporting to statutory authorities.
- **4.3 Cold Chain:** Thermolabile medicines (Insulin, etc.) must be delivered in validated cold-chain containers.
- **4.4 Confidentiality:** All patient and transaction data are strictly confidential.
- **4.5 Personnel:** "Pharmacists deployed for NCRA duties must be qualified (B.Pharm/D.Pharm) and registered with the State Pharmacy Council. Their conduct must align with NCRA-TIFR's workplace decorum."
- **4.6. Random Testing:** "NCRA reserves the right to send samples of supplied medicines for independent lab testing. Costs shall be borne by the pharmacy if the supplied medicine found not meeting the prescribed standard."

5. Return of Medicines

- **5.1 Eligibility for Return:** The pharmacy shall accept returns of sealed, undamaged medicines in cases of:
 - (a) Change in prescription by MO,
 - (b) Adverse reactions, or
 - (c) Death of the beneficiary.
- **5.2 Expiry Protection:** No medicine with less than **6 months shelf-life** shall be supplied. If supplied, the pharmacy is liable to replace it or issue a credit note.
- **5.3 Processing:** Returns must be processed within 15 days, and a Credit Note must be issued to be adjusted in the next billing cycle.

6. Penalties & Service Compliance

- **6.1 Delay:** Late delivery beyond stipulated times shall attract penalties as per NCRA norms.
- **6.2 Non-Supply:** Failure to supply a prescribed medicine within 24 hrs from collection of prescription will attract a penalty of **minimum 20% of the MRP**. NCRA reserves the right to purchase unsupplied medicines from open markets at the **bidder's risk and cost**.
- **6.4 Warning System:** "Three written warnings within a quarter shall lead to a mandatory review of the contract by NCRA Administration, which may result in termination."
- **Graded Penalty Scale:**
 - *Delay in Delivery:* 0.5% of the bill value per hour of delay.
 - *Failure to supply:* Failure to supply a prescribed medicine within 24 hrs from collection of prescription will attract a penalty of **minimum 20% of the MRP**.
 - *Wrong Medicine Supply:* Flat penalty of Rs. 200/- per instance plus immediate replacement.
 - *Incomplete Billing:* Deferment of the entire batch payment until rectification.

7. Administration & Dispute Resolution

- **7.1 Finality:** Any dispute shall be resolved amicably; failing which, the **decision of the Competent authority at NCRA-TIFR shall be final and binding.**
- **7.2 Medico-Legal:** Any medico-legal matters arising from supplied drugs must be handled by the bidder at their own cost.
- **7.3 Jurisdiction:** Subject to the jurisdiction of courts at Pune.

8. Provision of On-Campus Pharmacy

- **8.1 Future Scope:** NCRA reserves the right to ask the bidder to operate a store within the NCRA premises at a later date.
- **8.2 Terms:** Infrastructure and license fees for on-campus operations shall be decided as per prevailing Government/Institute guidelines.

9. Contract Execution

- **9.1 Contract validity:** 01 Year
- **9.2 Notice period for termination:** 30 days from either side. However, NCRA reserves the right to terminate the contract without notice in case of serious violation of terms and contract.

10. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

The Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) will be accepted only in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft (in Favour of TIFR payable at Pune), Fixed Deposit Receipt (any one) from any National Bank / Scheduled Bank or payment online in an acceptable form, safeguarding the purchaser's interest in all respects for the following purpose (Drawn in favour of Centre Director, NCRA-TIFR, Pune).

11. Benefits to MSEs and Start-up as per the extent guidelines of the Govt. of India subject to submission of relevant valid documents.

12. Corrupt, fraudulent or unethical practices

- a) NCRA requires that the Medicine Supplier observe the highest standards of ethics during the procurement and execution of a contract for the supply of medicines. The medicines/drugs to be supplied will be of standard quality. In pursuance thereof, the terms are set forth as follows:
- b) NCRA will declare a Medicine Supplier ineligible, either indefinitely or for a specified period of time, for award of the contract, if at any time, it determines that the Medicine Supplier has engaged in corrupt and fraudulent practices in executing the contract.
- c) NCRA may, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, at its sole discretion, terminate the contract in whole or in part in respect of any Medicine Supplier for any of the following reasons:
 - I. Supply of sub-standard/spurious/substitute medicines.
 - II. Delay in supply/refusal to supply/non-supply of medicines.
 - III. Overcharging on the bill.
 - IV. In case it is found that any particular medicine's date has expired or is near the date of expiry.
 - V. If the Medicine Supplier fails to perform any other obligation (s) under the contract
- d) If any such case indicated in (c) above is noticed during subsequent scrutiny after or before the payment, then the Medicine Supplier shall refund the disputed/excess amount already paid by the NCRA and replace the medicines in question. NCRA may stop payments due or recover the cost of such supplies from the amounts due to the Medicine Supplier

13. Applicability of best prices

If the Medicine Supplier with whom the NCRA has entered into a purchase contract offers a higher discount or sells or even offers to sell medicines following conditions of sale similar to those of the NCRA's contract, to any person or organization during the currency of the rate contract, the discount rate applicable to the NCRA will be automatically increased with effect from that date for all the subsequent supplies under the contract and the contract amended accordingly.

14. Indemnity:

The Medicine Supplier shall indemnify the NCRA against all actions, suits, claims and demands brought or made against the NCRA in respect of anything done or committed to be done by the Medicine Supplier in execution of or in connection with the work of this contract and against any loss or damage to the NCRA in consequence to any action or suit being brought against the Medicine Supplier for anything done or committed to be done in the execution of this contract.

15. The bidders are advised to visit NCRA-TIFR, Pune to understand the exact scope of the work and all other relevant aspects related to the execution of the work. However, this will not be a Cause for disqualification of a bidder.

GENERAL GUIDELINES TO BIDDERS ON CPPP E-PROCUREMENT MODULE

1. Procedure for Registration by the Bidder

- 1.1. Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>) by clicking on the link "Click here to Enroll" on the CPP Portal.
- 1.2. As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- 1.3. Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
- 1.4. Upon enrollment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / TCS / nCode / eMudhra etc.), with their profile.
